FAAN's mission is to raise public awareness, to provide advocacy and education, and to advance research on behalf of all those affected by food allergies and anaphylaxis. FAAN's membership now stands at close to 30,000 worldwide and includes families, dietitians, nurses, physicians, school staff, and representatives from government agencies and the food and pharmaceutical industries. FAAN serves as the communication link between the patient and others. FAAN supports and participates in research studies focusing on the epidemiology of food allergy.

The entry fee is \$100 per team (two anglers per team) – all proceeds, including 100% of all entry fees, will go to FAAN®. All participants will receive a "Fishing for a Cure" T-Shirt, courtesy of Exelon. All anglers must compete from a boat with a minimum length of 16 feet with kill switches and aerated live wells. Anglers must be at least 16 years old or accompanied by an adult to compete. No live bait and no illicit drugs or alcoholic beverages permitted during competition. All boats must maintain a minimum of \$100,000 liability insurance. Life vests must be worn any time the big motor is running. All participants must sign a liability release waiver before commencement of tournament. Winners may be administered a polygraph prior to the issuance of prize monies. Anglers must comply with all state boating and fishing regulations. There is a three fish per team limit and minimum length of 15 inches. There will be penalties for short or dead fish. American Bass Anglers, Inc. will assist in managing the tournament. Exelon will have final authority for weigh in and will determine prizewinners.

Registration is limited to the first 100 teams. Based on availability, ramp sign-ups may be allowed the day of the event. **Make Checks payable to Exelon Nuclear and mail to:**

- A. **LIABILITY RELEASE:** In signing this agreement, which I acknowledge is a condition of my participation in this event, I hereby release Exelon Nuclear AND American Bass Anglers, Inc., its directors, officers, agents, employees, affiliates, successors, assigns and sponsors ("Exelon" and "ABA") from any and all causes of action; claims, demands, losses, damages, expenses (including attorneys fees and costs) and liabilities of any kind ("Losses") arising from or relating to injury of any persons or any property which I may sustain or which I may cause by reason of participating in or in connection with this tournament. I understand that by participating in this tournament that I may cause or sustain injury including but not limited to: loss of limbs, paralysis, coma, loss of mental functions, loss of sight, loss of speech/smell, dehydration, exposure, hypothermia, frostbite, sun stroke and all other injuries that may be caused in a boating accident and/or exposure to the elements. I further release Exelon and ABA for all Losses relating to adverse weather conditions in this tournament. It is my responsibility to seek safety should adverse and/or unforeseen weather conditions occur prior to, during or after the tournament.
- B. **COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND WAIVER OF SUBROGATION:** In signing this agreement, I further covenant and agree not to sue Exelon and/or ABA for damages on account of any injury, death or damage I suffer or cause whether known now or which may develop in the future, and I expressly waive any right to sue that I may have. In the event Exelon and/or ABA is sued because of my actions, I expressly agree to indemnify and hold harmless Exelon and ABA from and against any losses. I understand that in waiving my right to sue Exelon and/or ABA, I am also waiving the rights to recovery from Exelon and/or ABA of my insurance carrier for any claims they may pay on my behalf.
- C. **VERIFICATION OF LIABILITY INSURANCE:** I verify that I maintain a minimum of \$100,000 liability insurance on the boat I will use in this tournament.
- D. **POLYGRAPH/VOICE STRESS TEST:** Failure to take or pass the polygraph/voice stress examination will result in immediate disqualification without recourse.
- E. **LIKENESS/PHOTO RELEASE:** In consideration for permission to participate in the Tournament, I hereby grant to Exelon and ABA, the unconditional right to use my name, voice, photographic likeness, biographical information, fishing tips and/or instruction in any medium whatsoever, including but not limited to video/audio productions, merchandising, promotions, articles, and/or press releases, in connection with this tournament. I understand that I will not be entitled to receive any royalties or other compensation in connection with such use.
- F. I **SIGNIFY** by my signature that I have read all tournament rules and this liability release and agree to abide by all rules, regulations, releases and tournament official's decisions.
